We help communities organize for action and keep coalitions energized and moving forward. This learning community approach to peer technical assistance is an exciting way to experience and share the skills, tools, methods and results of all communities. By

organizing to generate greater political will at the local level, we can in turn leverage this influence within states and the nation to sustain larger scale change than we can accomplish separately. This includes:

- Management information systems best practices;
- Strategies to include and engage health providers;

**Who Should Join CJA?**

There are three types of membership so that you can participate at the level that best fits your needs:

**Sponsor Level:** \$1,000 contribution as a sponsor member will provide permanent recognition on all CJA materials and give you a voice in shaping an organization that is in the early stages of development and influence. Membership at this level is open to anyone who is committed to assuring the success of CJA and supporting community driven health care reform.
